Pursuant to the California Property and Business Improvement District Law of 1994 (Streets and Highways Code 36600 et seq.) and City and County of San Francisco Business and Tax Regulations Code Article 15, this is to notify you that a public hearing on the renewal and expansion of a property and business improvement district in your area was continued to December 13, 2011 at 3:00 p.m.

Formation of the property and business improvement district is subject to the approval of the Board of Supervisors after noticed public hearings and a vote by the property owners who would be subject to the assessments. Following public comment, ballots submitted by the property owners in the proposed Fillmore Community Benefit District (CBD) will be counted by the Department of Elections and the results will be announced by the Board of Supervisors. If the ballot election does not result in a majority protest against formation of the proposed district, the Board of Supervisors may vote to establish the CBD. If there is a majority protest, there will be no renewal of the CBD and no vote by the Board of Supervisors.

Property owners may vote or change their vote on the CBD renewal ballot until the end of the public hearing on December 13, 2011. To request a duplicate ballot, please contact Cuong Quach, Department of Elections, by email: Cuong.Quach@sfgov.org or phone: (415) 554-4342.

If this Property and Business Improvement District is formed, it would authorize assessments against real property in the district for 7 years, July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2018, with services to be implemented January 2012 through December 2018. The CBD would fund and provide the following services:

- 1) Cleaning & Maintenance
- 2) Public Safety
- 3) Marketing
- 4) Streetscape Improvements and Beautification
- 5) Advocacy
- 6) Management and Operations
