CALLING AND PROVIDING FOR A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO AND THE CITY OF BRISBANE ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 6, 2001, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE VOTERS A PROPOSAL TO FORM A MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT FOR THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO AND THE CITY OF BRISBANE, TO BE KNOWN AS THE "SAN FRANCISCO-BRISBANE MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT"; CONSOLIDATING THE SPECIAL ELECTION WITH THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO ON NOVEMBER 6, 2001.

A petition for submission to the voters of a proposal for the formation of a municipal utility district for the City and County of San Francisco and the City of Brisbane has been (1) submitted pursuant to California Public Utilities Code sections 11611 et seq., and (2) referred by the San Francisco Local Agency Formation Commission to the Board of Supervisors to call an election to submit the petition to the voters.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED, That a special election is hereby called and ordered to be held in the City and County of San Francisco and the City of Brisbane on Tuesday, November 6, 2001, for the purpose of submitting to the voters a proposal to form a municipal utility district for the City and County of San Francisco and the City of Brisbane, to be known as the "San Francisco-Brisbane Municipal Utility District"; and, be it

FURTHER MOVED, That the special election shall be held and conducted and the votes thereafter received and canvassed, and the returns thereof made and the results thereof ascertained, determined and declared as herein provided and in all particulars not herein recited such election shall be held according to the laws of the State of California and all other applicable laws providing for and governing elections in the City and County of San

24 25 Francisco and the City of Brisbane, and the polls for such election shall be and remain open during the time required by such laws; and, be it

FURTHER MOVED, That the special election hereby called shall be and hereby is consolidated with the general municipal election scheduled for Tuesday, November 6, 2001, in the City and County of San Francisco; and the voting precincts, polling places, voting booths, and election officials in San Francisco shall in every case be the same; there shall be only one set of election officers in each precinct, to wit: the election officers to be appointed by the Director of Elections for each of said precincts; the candidates and measures at the general municipal election shall be set forth on the ballots for said special election; all proceedings had in the premises shall be recorded in one set of documents; the election shall be held in all respects as though there were only one election; and, the returns of said general municipal election and special election shall be canvassed by the Director of Elections, all as provided in the Elections Code of the State of California and all other applicable laws, and reference is hereby made to the notice of election setting forth the voting precincts, polling places and officers of election for the November 6, 2000 general municipal election to be published by the Director of Elections in the official newspapers of the City and County on the date required under the laws of the State of California; and, be it

FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco urges the City Council of the City of Brisbane to consolidate said election with the general election to be held in Brisbane on Tuesday, November 6, 2001.
