Ordinance amending Article XIII of the San Francisco Administrative Code by amending Sections 10.100-28, 10.100-30 and 10.100-34 to redesignate the Arts Commission Market Street Art Maintenance Fund and the Arts Commission Youth Arts Fund as sub-accounts of of the Arts Commission Public Arts Fund.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by amending Section 10.100-28 to read as follows:

SEC. 10.100-28. ART COMMISSION MARKET STREET ART MAINTENANCE FUND ACCOUNT.

- (a) Establishment of Fund Account. The Art Commission Market Street Art

 Maintenance Fund Account is established as a separate account within the Arts Commission Public

 Arts Fund under Section 10.100-30 of the San Francisco Administrative Code, a category four fund,
 to receive the City and County's share of advertising revenues from transit shelter advertising
 on Market Street, as provided in the Advertising Transit Shelter Agreement, as amended.

 Additionally, any monies appropriated by the Board of Supervisors for maintenance of art on
 Market Street shall be deposited in this fund account.
- (b) **Use of the** *Fund Account*. The *fund monies in this account* shall be *used expended* exclusively for the maintenance and restoration of public art on Market Street.

Section 2. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by amending Section 10.100-30 to read as follows:

SEC. 10.100-30. ART COMMISSION PUBLIC ARTS FUND.

- (a) Establishment of Fund. The Art Commission Public Arts Fund is established as a category six four fund to receive all revenue from programs, events, and sale or use of works of art which are under the supervision and control of the Art Commission as well as monies collected and deposited under the Arts Commission Market Street Art Maintenance Account and Arts Commission Youth Arts Account in accordance with Administrative Code Sections 10.100-28 and 10.100-34.
- (b) **Use of Fund.** Unless otherwise provided by Charter, municipal code, contract or funding source, the The monies in said fund are for expenditure exclusively shall be expended only for the purpose of conducting arts programs and events, the character and nature of which shall be determined by the Art Commission. Any revenue collected from the sale, exchange, or exhibition of a work of art under the jurisdiction of the Art Commission shall be expended exclusively for the purpose of acquiring or maintaining works of art for the same public structure or purpose for which the original work of art was acquired.
- (c) Exceptions to Fund Category. The Art Commission shall authorize all expenditures from the fund. *Any unexpended balance available at the end of any fiscal year in excess of \$500,000 shall, subject to the review of the Controller, be placed in the General Fund.*
- (d) Administration of Fund. The Art Commission shall, on or before February 1, 1983, and thereafter on or before February 1st, annually, submit in writing to the Board of Supervisors and to its Finance Committee, a report showing the total revenue credited to said special fund to and including

the date of said report and a description of the programs and events for which the revenue credited to said special fund is to be expended.

Section 3. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by amending Section 10.100-34 to read as follows:

SEC. 10.100-34. ART COMMISSION YOUTH ARTS FUND ACCOUNT.

- (a) **Establishment of** *Fund Account*. The Art Commission Youth Arts Fund *Fund Account* is established as *a separate account within the Arts Commission Public Arts Fund under Section 10.100-30 of the San Francisco Administrative Code*, a category four fund, to receive half of the annual payment made to the City under Section II.B of the Advertising Transit Shelter Agreement, as amended, and any monies appropriated by the Board of Supervisors for youth arts programs.
- (b) **Use of the** *Fund* <u>Account</u>. The *fund* <u>monies in this account</u> shall be <u>used expended</u> exclusively for providing programs and opportunities for the talents and creativity of young artists.
