The Department of Human Services shall not require fingerprint biometric imaging of clients in order to access services, unless required by State, Federal, or grant programs, or those fequired expressly authorized by voter initiative, or the County Adult Assistance Programs including Personal Assistance Employment Services (PAES), Supplemental Security Income Pending (SSIP), Cash Assistance Linked to MediCal (CALM), and General Assistance (GA).
