Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by adding

Section 7.4-1, to read as follows:

SEC. 7.4-1. REPORTS TO DISASTER COUNCIL.

Following any declared emergency, activation of the City's Emergency Operations Center, or

credible disaster warning, the Office of Emergency Services shall submit a written report to the

Disaster Council and the Board of Supervisors describing and evaluating the City's response.
