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Section 3. Of the above appropriated amount, \$282,342, representing 0.2% of the expenditure budget net of bond financing and audit costs is to be allocated and available to support the Controller's Audit Fund, pursuant to Charter Appendix F1.113; and \$29,912, representing 0.05% of gross bond proceeds is to be allocated and available to support the Public Utilities Commission Revenue Bond Oversight Committee, pursuant to Administrative Code Section 5A.31. These appropriations may be increased or decreased by the Controller based on changes to expenditure appropriations or actual gross bond proceeds to conform to the applicable Charter and Administrative Code formulas.

Section 4. Associated Bond financing costs for Hetchy Water, \$7,802,191 and Hetchy Power, \$2,106,555 is also hereby appropriated, including but not limited to, issuance costs, debt service reserve, capitalized interest, rating agency, disclosure costs and \$29,912 for Revenue Bond Oversight Committee costs, all on controllers reserve pending receipt of bond proceeds. To the extent that net available bond proceeds after financing costs are more than budgeted, the Department may use such surplus bond proceeds as a substitute

1 for other sources budgeted in this appropriation.

3 Section 5. The appropriations herein are effective as of July 1, 2012. The bond-funded
4 portion of all included appropriation shall be placed on Controller's Reserve pending the
5 availability of funds. The portion of appropriation funded by FY 2013-14 operating revenues
6 shall be placed on Controller's Reserve until July 1, 2013. Release of project-related
7 appropriation reserves by the Controller is also subject to the prior occurrence of the
8 SFPUC's and the Board of Supervisors' discretionary adoption of CEQA findings for
9 projects, following review and consideration of completed project-related environmental
10 analysis, where required, pursuant to CEQA, the State CEQA Guidelines, and Chapter 31 of
11 the San Francisco Administrative Code.

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13 Section 6. This supplemental appropriation reflects the funding and appropriation available
14 for Fiscal Year 2012-2013 and Fiscal Year 2013-2014 and therefore, will be budgeted July
15 1, 2012 consistent with the SFPUC's two-year budget submission.

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17 Section 7. The Controller is authorized to record transfers between funds and adjust the
18 accounting treatment of sources and uses appropriated in this ordinance as necessary to
19 conform to Generally Accepted Accounting Principles.
