ORDINANCE NO. 154-12

[Contract Extension - SFPark - Serco Inc.]

Ordinance authorizing the Municipal Transportation Agency to extend the existing contract with Serco Inc. until June 30, 2014, by waiving the two year limitation on the exception for pilot programs to the competitive procurement requirements of Chapter 21 of the San Francisco Administrative Code; and making environmental findings and findings of consistency with the General Plan.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Environmental Findings. The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in this Ordinance are in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 120432 and is incorporated herein by reference. The Board has considered the exemption determination by the Planning Department and the whole record before it and hereby affirms said exemption determination and adopts the determination as its own and finds that there are no substantial project changes, no substantial changes in project circumstances, and no new information of substantial importance that would change the conclusions set forth in the exemption determination by the Planning Department that the proposed project is exempt from environmental review under the California Environmental Quality Act.

Section 1. Findings.

San Francisco Administrative Code Section 21.5 establishes a two year limit for pilot project contracts that have not been competitively procured. Any contract extension beyond the two year limit shall be subject to all applicable competitive procurement requirements.

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1. On June 1, 2008, the Municipal Transportation Agency entered into a two-year pilot project Agreement with Serco Inc. to provide various on-street parking meter and parking control projects for the SF*park* Program. The Agreement was exempt from the competitive bidding requirements of Chapter 21 of the San Francisco Administrative Code pursuant to Section 21.5.

2. On February 9, 2010, the Board of Supervisors approved uncodified Ordinance No. 35-10 to authorize the Municipal Transportation Agency to extend the Serco Inc. Agreement for an additional twenty-five months by waiving the two-year limit for pilot project contracts that have not been competitively procured. This authorization expires on July 1, 2012.

3. The Municipal Transportation Agency is now seeking further authorization from the Board of Supervisors to extend this Agreement until June 30, 2014, by again waiving the two year limitation on the exception for pilot programs to the competitive procurement requirements of Chapter 21 of the San Francisco Administrative Code.

4. The Serco Inc. Agreement needs to be extended until June 30, 2014, for several reasons. These reasons include the fact that: (1) the Municipal Transportation Agency did not receive the SF*park* Supplemental Agreement from CalTrans until June, 2009, which resulted in the project starting behind schedule, (2) the original parking sensor vendor could not meet performance requirements for the project, (3) the technical complexity involved in having multiple vendors supporting the project resulted in significant delays, (4) if the contract terminates in June, 2012, the SF*park* program will have operated for only ten months which will result in insufficient data collection and evaluation to meet the requirements of the Federal Highway Administration's grant funding requirements, and (5) extending this Agreement will allow the Municipal Transportation Agency to prepare for and execute a transition plan for a Citywide approach to parking management.

Supervisors Chiu, Olague BOARD OF SUPERVISORS Section 2. The Municipal Transportation Agency is authorized to enter into the Agreement to extend the existing contract with Serco Inc. until June 30, 2014, substantially in the form in Board file <u>120432</u>. The Board of Supervisors hereby waives the two year limitation on the exception for pilot programs to the competitive procurement requirements of Chapter 21 of the San Francisco Administrative Code with respect to this contract.
