[Urging removal of Boy Scout Language]

Resolution urging the United States Congress to remove language from the federal education bill regarding the Boy Scouts.

WHEREAS, The United States Congress has through a joint Senate House Committee introduced an education bill that would require yearly testing and penalize low performing schools that do not show improvement; and,

WHEREAS, The bill includes a large increase in federal Title I funds to support schools with low income children, and authorize \$26.5 billion for K-12 schools and \$1 billion for a new reading initiative; and,

WHEREAS, The Bill authorizes additional funds for teacher training, but requires states to certify that all teachers are qualified to teach in their subject area in four years; and,

WHEREAS, The bill strips federal funds from any school district that sanctions the Boy Scouts or other groups that bar homosexuals; and,

WHEREAS, San Francisco and the State of California have prohibited discrimination in employment on the basis of sexual orientation; and,

WHEREAS, The federal education bill in its current form would place local school districts in the precarious position of having to decide between violating local law and encouraging

discrimination in order to secure federal education funds; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby urges the United States Congress to remove language from the federal education bill regarding the Boy Scouts.
