Resolution urging the California State Department of Education to establish in the California State History Framework fair and accurate standards in the portrayal of the atrocities against the Chinese during the Sino-Japanese War.

WHEREAS, The State Department of Education seeks to ensure that comprehensive, unbiased and accurate information is available and taught in all California educational institutions; and

WHEREAS, An accurate rendering of historical events is vital to the understanding of historical epochs, and of subsequent civic, social, political and economic decisions and actions even to the present day; and,

WHEREAS, The California State History Framework, through which these historical events are depicted, does not currently present a fair and accurate accounting of the atrocities perpetrated against the Chinese in the Sino-Japanese War; and,

WHEREAS, This omission represents a direct affront to the large population of Chinese Americans residing in California; and,

WHEREAS, This omission does a great disservice to the entire body of students who utilize the California State Historical Framework, and who deserve and require a complete and accurate rendering of historical fact; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco ask our State Representatives to urge the State Department of Education to ensure that the California State Historical Framework incorporate fair and accurate standards in the portrayal of the atrocities against the Chinese during the Sino-Japanese War; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco urges that the California textbooks reflect these fair and accurate standards in their portrayal of the atrocities against the Chinese during the Sino-Japanese War; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco urges that these standards be put into place in the texts, curriculum, and other instructional materials within the California State History Framework, so that the historical record available in our educational institutions regains the accuracy that this omission has so seriously compromised.
