WHEREAS, The Native American Health Center for the Bay Area and Friendship House Association of American Indians recently secured ten multi-year grants from the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) \$11 million in grants for a five year period for targeted prevention and treatment services; and,

WHEREAS, The Friendship House Association of American
Indians of San Francisco is a nonprofit community-based
organization that has provided substance abuse treatment and
recovery programs since 1963 and currently provides a full
continuum of culturally competent services; now, therefore be it
