Nancy Rubin, new position, seat 1, must be representative of non-profit health, affordable housing development, and human service organizations, for a new one-year term ending December 10, 2002;

Tony Michelini, new position, seat 2, must be representative of non-profit health, affordable housing development, and human service organizations, for a new one-year term ending December 10, 2002;

Sandy Mori, new position, seat 3, must be representative of non-profit health, affordable housing development, and human service organizations, for a new one-year term ending December 10, 2002;

Johnathan Vernick (residency requirement waived), new position, seat 4, must be representative of non-profit health, affordable housing development, and human service organizations, for a new one-year term ending December 10, 2002;

James Illig, new position, seat 5, must be representative of non-profit health, affordable housing development, and human service organizations, for a new one-year term ending December 10, 2002; Tiffany Mock-Goeman (residency requirement waived), new position, seat 6, must be representative of non-profit health, affordable housing development, and human service organizations, for a new one-year term ending December 10, 2002;

Salvador Menjivar (residency requirement waived), new position, seat 7, must be representative of non-profit health, affordable housing development, and human service organizations, for a new one-year term ending December 10, 2002; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 1. The membership of the City Non-Profit Contracting Task Force has a goal to be representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.
- 2. Applicants Johnathan Vernick, Tiffany Mock-Goeman, and Salvador Menjivar, new appointees, who are not residents of San Francisco, are persons with experience that uniquely qualifies him/her to serve on the City Non-Profit Contracting Task Force.
- 3. The City Non-Profit Contracting Task Force has attempted to fill the position, for which Johnathan Vernick, Tiffany Mock-Goeman, and Salvador Menjivar were nominated, with an individuals who are City residents and who have the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable to do so at this time. The Rules Committee has certified that Johnathan Vernick, Tiffany Mock-Goeman, and Salvador Menjivar are qualified to serve on the City Non-Profit Contracting Task Force.
- 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there are no other possible representative, who are residents of San Francisco and who have the specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by these applicants, and who are willing to serve on the City Non-Profit Contracting Task Force at this time; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirement for Johnathan Vernick, Tiffany Mock-Goeman, and Salvador Menjivar, as allowed in cases where no qualified City resident, willing to serve, can be found, pursuant to Section 4.101 of the City Charter that requires person(s) appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.
