[Urging the establishment of civil unions in California]

Resolution urging the California State Assembly to enact legislation establishing civil unions.

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco, which has a diverse population of ethnic and cultural groups including samesex domestic partners, has a particular stake in the protection and expansion of civil rights for all people; and,

WHEREAS, According to U.S. Census data, approximately
400,000 same-gender couples reside in California and many of
them are registered domestic partners raising children together;
and,

WHEREAS, Same-gender domestic partners, in a free and non-discriminatory society, deserve all the rights and privileges of married couples; and,

WHEREAS, Without the same legal rights, protections, benefits, and responsibilities, gay and lesbian families suffer numerous obstacles and hardships which directly harms them, and leads to numerous costs to third parties and the State; and,

WHEREAS, The concept of civil unions, established in the state of Vermont in 2000, provides a remedy to the inequalities faced by gay and lesbian domestic partners without violating section 308.5 of the California Family Code commonly known as

the Knight Initiative or Proposition 22 which was passed on March 7, 2000; and,

WHEREAS, The California Family Protection Act sponsored by Assemblyman Paul Koretz will establish civil unions and will extend the protections of California family law to same-sex domestic partners including: the rights and obligations of support and community property; child custody, visitation, and stepparent adoption; title, probate, and other issues involving the ownership and transfer of real or personal property; government benefits and tax responsibilities; legal claims such as wrongful death and infliction of emotional distress; health insurance and family leave benefits; and medical consent, guardianship, and disposition of remains; and,

WHEREAS, A majority of Californians support giving same-gender couples the full legal rights and benefits of married couples when a concept other than marriage is applied; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby urges the California State

Assembly and the Governor to enact the California Family

Protection Act establishing civil unions for same-gender couples in California; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the Board shall send copies of this resolution to Governor Gray Davis, Speaker of the Assembly Robert Hertzberg, Speaker pro Tempore Fred Keeley,

Assemblyman Paul Koretz, State Senators John Burton and Jackie Speier, and State Assembly Representatives Carole Migden and Kevin Shelley.
