WHEREAS, Sacred Heart Cathedral Preparatory is celebrating its 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary, its sesquicentennial anniversary, in San Francisco on January 30, 2002; and,

WHEREAS, The people of San Francisco extend their best wishes to the vibrant student community, the strong alumni family, and the parents and friends of Sacred Heart Cathedral Preparatory on this grand occasion; now, therefore, be it
