Development, was deemed eligible to move to the RFP stage; and,

WHEREAS, The RFP stage is a critical time for the community to offer input and direction into the redevelopment of the Islands; and,

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors in 1996 adopted "The Sustainability Plan for the City and County of San Francisco;" and,

WHEREAS, Elements of sustainable development should be incorporated into the RFP; and,

WHEREAS, Increased traffic congestion on the Bay Bridge, the enjoyment of being on the islands, and sustainability goals all demonstrate a need to make the Islands as car-free as possible; and,

WHEREAS, Another element of the RFP should be a specific commitment to clean ferry service, powered by renewable energy, to existing ferry terminals; and,

WHEREAS, The RFP should include the construction of a wetlands system for water treatment, wildlife habitat, environmental education, and visitor enjoyment; and,

WHEREAS, The RFP should also require adherence to the best management practices of the City's Resource Efficient Buildings Program; and,

WHEREAS, Another element of the RFP should require the preservation of a generous amount of open space to serve the needs of the Islands' residents and visitors; and,

WHEREAS, The RFP should respect the spirit and letter of the Public Trust Doctrine; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby urges the Treasure Island
