RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does hereby appoint the hereinafter designated persons to serve as members of the Drug Abuse Advisory Board, pursuant to the provisions of the San Francisco Administrative Code, Section 15.9, for the term specified:

Robert Wood, succeeding Leon Winston, seat 3, must represent the public at large, for the unexpired portion of a three-year term ending October 1 2004;

Keith Fowler, succeeding Nick Roomel, seat 8, must represent the public at large, for the unexpired portion of a three-year term ending October 1 2004;

Paul Aguilar (residency requirement waived), succeeding Jackson Wong, seat 9, must represent the public at large, for the unexpired portion of a three-year term ending October 1 2004;

Brian Haley, succeeding Frederick Hobson, seat 13, must represent the public at large, for the unexpired portion of a three-year term ending October 1 2003; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

1. The membership of the Drug Abuse Advisory Board has a goal to be representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.

2. Applicant Paul Aguilar, a new appointee, who is not a resident of San Francisco, is a person with experience that uniquely qualifies him/her to serve on the Drug Abuse Advisory Board.

- 3. The the Drug Abuse Advisory Board has attempted to fill the position, for which Paul Aguilar was nominated, with an individual who is a City resident and who has the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable to do so at this time. The Rules Committee has certified that Paul Aguilar is qualified to serve on the Drug Abuse Advisory Board.
- 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is no other possible representative, who is a resident of San Francisco and who has the specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this applicant, and who is willing to serve on the Drug Abuse Advisory Board at this time; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirement for Paul Aguilar, as allowed in cases where no qualified City resident, willing to serve, can be found, pursuant to Section 4.101 of the City Charter that requires person(s) appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.
