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[Satellite Charter Schools resolution]

Resolution urging the California State Legislature to introduce legislation restricting the establishment and operation of charter schools and their satellite campuses to the county in which the original charter was issued.

WHEREAS, The Charter Schools Act of 1992 specifically designates the maximum number of charter schools authorized to operate annually within the State of California; and,

WHEREAS, This rate has been mandated specifically to regulate growth pending a formal evaluation of the effectiveness of the charter school system in 2003; and,

WHEREAS, Existing provisions in the Charter Schools Act allow for schools who have been granted a single charter within one county to operate numerous "satellite" campuses throughout the state, effectively bypassing the state's regulated growth plan; and,

WHEREAS, Supervisory responsibility for these satellites lies within the school board that issued the charter, regardless of the location of the satellites; and, due to the geographical and financial constraints of the local school boards, there is often little or no formal oversight of these satellite campuses; and,

WHEREAS, Charter schools are part of the public school system and as such receive public funding based on their reported average daily attendance (ADA); and,

WHEREAS, The proliferation of satellite campuses and the subsequent lack of oversight has created a system prone to fraud and mismanagement of public funds; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the California State Legislature to restrict the creation and operation of charter satellite campuses to the county of issuance and

that it require each satellite to obtain the approval of the local Board of Education; and, therefore, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, The Board of Supervisors directs the Clerk of the Board to forward this resolution to the San Francisco delegation to the California Sate Legislature and to the Governor of California.
