[Support for Senate Bill 1528.]

Resolution urging the State Legislature to adopt Senate Bill 1528 introduced by Senator Edward Vincent, relating to an act to amend Section 22435.7 of the Business and Professions Code, relating to shopping carts.

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco has a substantial interest in promoting the public health, safety, welfare and convenience of its citizens and visitors by ensuring that public streets, sidewalks and rights-of-way not be obstructed by unattended empty shopping carts left on either public property or on private property without the owner's consent; and,

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco promotes the reduction of visual blight and clutter and litter problems associated with empty shopping carts; and,

WHEREAS, On February 20th, 2002, Senator Edward Vincent introduced Senate Bill 1528 with amendments to require that a shopping cart be reclaimed within two business days following the date of actual notice and would provide that the shopping cart be subject to applicable fees or fines commencing on the third business day following the date of actual notice; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco does hereby support the passage of Senate Bill 791; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco does hereby ask that copies of this legislation be sent to our state representatives and His Honor the Mayor, with instructions that all actions be taken for its successful passage.
