[Rectification of shortcomings in the Electoral Process]

Resolution directing the Department of Elections to rectify shortcomings in the Electoral Process made evident in the March 5 Primary Elections, and to report its plans and timetable for rectification of these shortcomings to the Board of Supervisors.

WHEREAS, The electoral process of March 5, 2002, was marred by the virtual disenfranchisement of a significant number of "decline-to-state" voters who were refused a party ballot at polling stations even when such ballot was requested; and,

WHEREAS, That disenfranchisement appeared to be a consequence particularly of two factors: insufficient training of election officers and lack of clear communication between election officers and voters due to language barriers; and,

WHEREAS, It is the obligation of the Department of Elections to ensure that the voting process is properly carried out and that all voters are given their full voting rights and opportunities; and,

WHEREAS, The factors responsible for the disenfranchisement of some "decline-tostate" voters can be addressed through, for example, more thorough training of election officers; fliers distributed to voters at polling stations in all major languages used in San Francisco informing "decline-to-state" voters of their choices in relation to voting for candidates of specific political parties; fliers distributed to voters at polling stations in all major languages used in San Francisco informing voters of the Department of Elections electionday hotline (staffed by speakers of all the major languages) for immediate response to queries and complaints; and phone access at all precinct polling places, to ensure that such

communication between election officials and voters can be carried out immediately; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Department of Elections act to rectify the shortcomings of the March 5 elections so that these issues are resolved prior to the forthcoming elections in November, 2002; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Department of Elections report back to the Board of Supervisors within ten days of the passage of this resolution regarding the Department's proposed plans and timetable for the rectification of the election shortcomings noted herein.
