WHEREAS, the voters, by passing Proposition J in 1994, mandated to provide outreach advertising to those communities which may not be adequately served by the official newspaper (s), pursuant to Article IX, Section 2.80 and 2.80-1 of the San Francisco Administrative Code; and,

WHEREAS, in each year, the Board of Supervisors shall designate the outreach periodical for each outreach community, pursuant to Article IX, Section 2.81-3 of the San Francisco Administrative Code; and,

WHEREAS, by adopting Resolution No. 745-01 on October 1, 2001, the Board of Supervisors designated the periodicals to provide outreach advertising and mandated that expenditures for the outreach advertising program in Fiscal Year 2001-2002 shall not exceed \$100,000 without further Board approval; and,

WHEREAS, the \$100,000 approved by the Board of Supervisors will be exhausted the week of April 22, 2002 and additional funds in the amount of 20,682 27,354 are needed to continue the outreach advertising program for the remainder of Fiscal Year 2001-2002; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors hereby approves funds in the amount of \$20,682 \$27,354 to provide for outreach advertising expenditures in Fiscal Year 2001-2002.
