[Stop Sign Designation – Union and Powell Streets]

Resolution urging the installation of 4-way Stop signs at the intersection of Union and Powell Streets.

WHEREAS, Currently the intersection of Union and Powell Streets is regulated by a 2-way stop signs; and

WHEREAS, 8,600 vehicles cross this intersection per day on Union Street, 5,900 vehicles cross per day on on Powell Street, and 3,000 pedestrians cross per day on Powell Street, and

WHEREAS, This high level of automobile and pedestrian volume, combined with the intersection's two-way Stop signs, have made this intersection dangerous for both pedestrians and vehicles; and

WHEREAS, Three accidents have occurred effecting MUNI buses and three correctable accidents have been reported to the Police Department, in addition to numerous citzen reports of accidents involving property damage that were not officially recorded; and,

WHEREAS, Residents and merchants in the vicinity of Union and Powell Streets have requested that this intersection be made a 4-way stop; and,

WHEREAS, In 2001, the Department of Parking and Traffic (DPT) conducted an investigation regarding the feasibility and necessity of installing additional stop signs at this intersection and stated that such installation of additional Stop signs at this intersection would enhance vehicular and pedestrian safety; and,

WHEREAS, It is extremely important for the City to implement DPT's recommendation in order to ensure traffic safety at this vibrant neighborhood intersection; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco, pursuant to applicable provisions of the California Vehicle Code, strongly urges the Department of Parking and Traffic to install 4-way Stop signs at the intersection of Union and Powell Streets.
