Resolution authorizing the Municipal Transportation Agency to accept and expend \$22,888,763 of Federal Section 5309 capital assistance for the purchase of new LRVs for San Francisco's Municipal Railway, excluding Administrative Overhead Costs.

WHEREAS, The Secretary of Transportation is authorized to make monies available pursuant to the Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century (TEA 21) for mass transportation projects; and

WHEREAS, The Municipal Transportation Agency, City and County of San Francisco, is an eligible claimant for FTA capital assistance projects pursuant to Section 5309 of the Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century; and

WHEREAS, The grant contract for financial assistance will impose certain obligations upon the applicant, including the provision by it of the local share of project costs; and

WHEREAS, The local share of project costs will be funded separately using a variety of sources including State of California Proposition 116 Bond Funds, Regional Bridge Toll Net Revenues, San Francisco Municipal Railway Improvement Corporation Funds, and/or San Francisco County Transportation Sales Taxes; and

WHEREAS, It is required by the U.S. Department of Transportation in accordance with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, that in connection with the filing of an application for federal assistance, the applicant give an assurance that it will comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the U.S. Department of Transportation requirements thereunder; and
