FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That a grant award notification has been received from the California Office of Traffic Safety; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco will adhere to the intended use and reporting requirements of the California Office of Traffic Safety regarding the Safe and Sober in San Francisco Project and all conditions specified in the grant agreement; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is agreed that any liability arising out of the performance of this grant award, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grantee and the authorizing agency, and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the grant funds hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the \$50,000 of contractual expenses be placed on reserve

pending the award of a contract and submission to the Public Works and Public Protec-

tion Committee of the Board of Supervisors of the contractor's estimated hours and hourly rates.
