[Remembering those who have died homeless]

Resolution remembering the hundreds of people who have died on the San Francisco streets and declaring May 19, 2002 as "a day of love and sorrow, remember(ing) more than 77 men, women and children who died homeless in San Francisco in 2001."

WHEREAS, At least 100 homeless people have died each year since 1987 and over 77 homeless individuals have died on the San Francisco streets in 2001; and

WHEREAS, According to official records kept by the City of San Francisco, at least 1,844 people have died homeless between the fourteen year period of 1987 and 2000; and

WHEREAS. The City of San Francisco failed to keep an official record in 2001; and

WHEREAS, Because the list of 77 names of people who died homeless was compiled by advocates without access to official records, this estimate falls short of the actual number of homeless deaths in San Francisco for 2001; and

WHEREAS, The deaths of homeless individuals deserve to be recognized through official City of San Francisco records; and

WHEREAS, The tracking of homeless deaths through official city record-keeping provides important statistics that can be utilized to develop policy which can effectively address the social problem of homelessness; and

WHEREAS, Religious Witness with Homeless People is organizing a Community Memorial Service to be held at 3:00 p.m. on Sunday, May 19, 2002 to commemorate the loss of at least 77 homeless individuals in 2001; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors remembers the 1,852 people who died homeless in San Francisco over the last 15 years; and

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urge City Hall to keep complete records of people who die homeless in San Francisco for each coming year; and

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors declare May 19, 2002 "A Day of Love and Sorrow, Remembering the Men, Women and Children Who Died Homeless in San Francisco in 2001."
