FURTHER RESOLVED, That the grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the District Attorney is authorized to execute on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco the necessary Grant Award Agreements for REACT Taskforce purposes, including any extensions, augmentations, or amendments thereof.
