WHEREAS, The closure of the San Francisco General Hospital Renal Center contradicts the UCSF Mission Statement; and

WHEREAS, The closure of the Renal Center would cost the jobs of some forty University employees; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco strongly opposes the closure of the SFGH Renal Center; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors opposes any reduction of services and staff; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors uges the Regents of the University of California to refrain from closing the San Francisco General Hospital Renal Center.
