Resolution urging the California State Legislature to pass and Governor Gray Davis to sign AB 1080 which requires state contractors to provide equal benefits to gay and lesbian employees with domestic partners.

WHEREAS, San Francisco has been a leading jurisdiction in the establishment of equal rights for Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, and Transgender people; and,

WHEREAS, In 1998 the San Francisco Board of Supervisors passed our landmark

Equal Benefits Ordinance which requires companies that contract with the City to offer

domestic partners of their employees the same benefits provided to married spouses; and,

WHEREAS, Since enactment of this ordinance, numerous jurisdictions have adopted similar policies including Berkeley, Los Angeles, Oakland, Seattle, and San Mateo County; and,

WHEREAS, When the San Francisco Equal Benefits Ordinance was first passed, only a handful of companies offered domestic partner benefits, and now over 150 *Fortune* 500 companies offers these benefits as well as other San Francisco City contractors which employ over 1.4 million people nationwide; and,

WHEREAS, Assemblywoman Christine Kehoe has authored AB 1080 which would prohibit agencies of the State of California from contracting with businesses that do not offer benefits to registered domestic partner employees equal to the benefits offered to married employees; and,

WHEREAS, AB 1080 is closely modeled after San Francisco's Equal Benefits

Ordinance and addresses the injustice of not receiving equal pay for equal work when 30 –

40% of all employee compensation comes in the form of non-salary benefits; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco urges the California State Legislature to adopt and Governor Gray Davis to sign AB 1080 ending domestic partner discrimination by State contractors in regard to benefits; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the Board of the Supervisors shall transmit copies of this resolution to Assemblymembers Christine Kehoe, Carole Migden, and Kevin Shelley, to State Senators Jackie Speier and John Burton, and to Governor Gray Davis.
