Resolution urging the Mayor to request that the Department of Public Works, the Recreation and Parks Department and any other city departments with public restrooms to open such facilities and to the greatest extent possible establish new public restroom facilities.

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco should do everything within its power, preemptively to keep the City clean and safe; and

WHEREAS, Public urination and defecation create a dangerously unhealthy and unsafe situation on the City's sidewalks and streets, and,

WHEREAS, Many public restrooms have been closed because of vandalism, maintenance and cleaning costs, or accessibility issues; and,

WHEREAS, The cost of maintaining, cleaning and making public restrooms accessible is negligible in comparison to the unknown costs to the residents of the City and County of San Francisco resulting from the unsanitary and unsafe conditions caused by public urination and defecation, and

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco, through the Department of Public Works, contracts with the JCDecaux San Francisco, Inc. to provide public toilets in exchange for the right to sell advertising on public service kiosks; and

WHEREAS, Under the terms of the contract, the City can obtain toilets in addition to those currently installed under the agreement, if it issues permits for the additional toilets and the corresponding public service kiosks before July 17, 2002; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That Board of Supervisors urges the Mayor to request that Department of Public Works, Recreation and Parks Department and any other city department that has

Supervisor#Hall, Daly, Newsom BOARD OF SUPERVISORS public restroom facilities which are currently closed to re-open those facilities as soon as possible, and to provide the necessary maintenance and cleaning to keep those facilities open and properly functioning; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That Board of Supervisors urges the Mayor to request that the Department of Public Works issue permits for the maximum number of toilets available under the contract with the JCDeCaux San Francisco, Inc. and the corresponding number of public service kiosks by July 17, 2002.
