[Amended Nondisposal Facility Element.]

Resolution adopting an amended Nondisposal Facility Element of the City's Integrated Waste Management Plan as required by California Public Resources Code section 41730.

WHEREAS, The California Public Resources Code (PRC) Section 41730 et seq., requires every California city and county to prepare and adopt a Nondisposal Facility Element (NDFE) as part of its Integrated Waste Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, The purpose of the NDFE is to identify all existing, expansion of existing, and proposed nondisposal facilities (NDFs) which will be used by a jurisdiction to assist in reaching the solid waste diversion mandates of PRC Section 41780, which specifies a goal of 50 percent diversion from landfill disposal; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to PRC Section 41730 et seq., the San Francisco Solid Waste Management Program prepared a NDFE that was adopted by the San Francisco Board of Supervisors on December 16, 1994 (on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 57-94-4, Resolution number 1015-94); and,

WHEREAS, Changes in the NDFs since adoption of the NDFE necessitate amending the original NDFE; and

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Department of the Environment has prepared an amended NDFE to reflect those changes; and

WHEREAS, PRC Section 41735 states that no environmental review is required for the NDFE; and

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors has conducted a duly noticed public hearing on the NDFE and has reviewed and considered this matter; and now therefore be it RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors hereby adopts the amended San Francisco Nondisposal Facility Element; and be it FURTHER RESOLVED, That the NDFE be transmitted to the California Integrated Waste Management Board.
