Resolution authorizing the City Administrator to apply for a grant in the amount of \$1.15 million from the Bay Area Air Quality Management District for the purpose of implementing programs to improve air quality.

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 434 created the Transportation Fund for Clean Air in the Bay Area and provided authority to the Bay Area Air Quality Management District (the District) to impose up to a \$4.00 surcharge on motor vehicle registration fees within its jurisdiction, to be used to implement specified transportation control measures included in the District's 1991 Bay Area Clean Air Plan; and

WHEREAS, The District has approved a surcharge on motor vehicles and is seeking applications from Bay Area cities, counties, school districts and other agencies to cover the cost of transportation programs and projects that achieve emission reductions from motor vehicles; and

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco supports the Bay Area Clean Air Plan; and

WHEREAS, The following City departments have developed programs and projects eligible for AB 434 program funding including: the Department of the Environment in the amount of \$1,000,000, to subsidize the purchase of Liquefied Natural Gas Refuse Trucks replacing diesel trucks for Normal Waste Systems, Inc.; and the Department of Parking and Traffic in the amount of \$149,600, to create bicycle lanes on Cabrillo Street; and

WHEREAS, The district requires all applications to be authorized by the applicant's governing board, or in this case, the Board of Supervisors; and

SUPERVISOR AMMIANO BOARD OF SUPERVISORS WHEREAS, An accept and expend resolution and any additional necessary documentation will be provided, as required, in the event any of these projects are designated for District funding awards; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the City Administrator, on behalf of the above named departments, is authorized to apply for a grant in the amount of \$1.15 million from the Transportation Fund for Clean Air for the programs enumerated above to reduce air pollution from motor vehicles.
