Resolution endorsing amendments and providing findings as to the local conditions supporting those amendments to the 2001 State Fire Code, as required by California Health and Safety Code.

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors is enacting a Fire Code for the City and County of San Francisco to be known as the "2001 San Francisco Fire Code"; and

WHEREAS, Some provisions of the 2001 San Francisco Fire Code are more restrictive than the 2001 State Fire Code; and

WHEREAS, California Health and Safety Code Sections 13143.5 and 18941.5 require the City to furnish reasons to the California Building Standards Commission for such deviations from the California Fire Code based upon local climatic, geologic or topographical conditions; and,

WHEREAS, Following are the local conditions justifying deviations from the 2001 California Fire Code:

Section 903.5. Geological - Due to possibility of seismic events, additional water supplies need to be accessible for firefighting operations to supplement or substitute for normal water supplies,

Section 1003.1.1.1. Geological and topographical - Due to possibility of seismic events, fire department apparatus may be required to supply water to sprinkler system. Additionally, due to topographical conditions, additional water supply from fire department apparatus may be necessary to increase hydraulic density to protect buildings adjacent to fire incident building,

Section 1003.2.3.9. Topographical - Due to unusual topographical conditions, including existing combustible piers, assembly occupancies require additional life safety protection,

Section 1004.2.1 Topographical - Due to the close proximity of buildings limited fire department access to some buildings, vertical standpipes may be necessary to allow successful firefighting operations,

Section 1004.3.1 Topographical - Due to the close proximity of buildings and construction to property lines, firefighting operations may require additional hose outlets,

Section 1006.3.1.1. Topographical - Due to the close proximity of buildings, quicker notification of sprinkler system activation is necessary to control fires,

Section 9001.1.1. Geological and topographical - Due to the possibility of seismic events, more reliable water supplies are required for sprinkler systems in high-rise buildings. Additionally, due to topographical conditions, including the close proximity of other buildings to high-rise buildings, highly reliable sprinkler systems are necessary to protect high-rise buildings and the surrounding areas,

Section 9001.1.2. Geological and topographical - Due to the possibility of seismic events, additional reliability of the emergency power supply system is necessary. Additionally, due to topographical conditions, including the close proximity of other buildings to high-rise buildings, highly reliable sprinkler and standpipe systems are necessary to protect high-rise buildings and the surrounding area,

Section 9001.1.3. Topographical - Due to unique topographical conditions, residential hotels are typically adjacent to other residential, commercial, and industrial buildings.

Unless listed in the following, any amendments to the California Fire Code were for administrative, informational, or clarification purposes. Informational purposes consist of interpretations of the code requirements including supplemental rules and regulations in order

to carry out the application and intent of the provisions as allowed in Section 101.4. Excluded from this list are any building standard requirements, which are not promulgated by the State of California and not adopted by the State Fire Marshal; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby find and determine that the aforesaid changes to the San Francisco Fire Code are necessary because of local conditions set forth above; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors is hereby directed to transmit this Resolution together with the San Francisco Fire Code to the California Building Standards Commission for filing, pursuant to the applicable provisions of law.
