Resolution urging Governor Davis to work with the California State Assembly to enact

Assembly Bill 60 as soon as possible.

[Supporting the Enactment of Assembly Bill 60]

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 60 would enable persons without a social security number to be issued a driver's license or identification card; and,

WHEREAS, On September 14, 2001 the California State Assembly passed Assembly Bill 60, however Governor Davis has not yet signed the bill into law; and,

WHEREAS, On November 5, 2001 the San Francisco Board of Supervisors passed a resolution urging the State of California and all State agencies, including the Department of Motor Vehicles to implement Assembly Bill 60; and,

WHEREAS, For almost one year Assembly Bill 60 has been delayed by the State of California; and,

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 60 will promote safer roads as it provides immigrants with the opportunity to obtain adequate training, testing, and insurance to become secure drivers; and,

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 60 will benefit the state of California's workforce by facilitating the efficiency of commute for immigrants, who serve a significant role in the state's labor force; and,

WHEREAS, The American Insurance Association, United Farm Workers of America International Chamber of Commerce, California Labor Federation, American Civil Liberties Union, Mexican American Legal Defense & Educational Fund, and Congress of California

Seniors support the measure, recognizing that its passage helps ensure public safety as it creates a new group of qualified licensed and insured drivers; and,

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco urges Governor Davis to work with the California State Assembly to enact Assembly Bill 60 as soon as possible; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors request that the Clerk of the Board transmit copies of this resolution to Governor Gray Davis and Assemblymember Cedillo.
