WHEREAS, in 1998 President Hugo Chavez was elected to the presidency of Venezuela through fair, open, and democratic elections.

WHEREAS, the Chavez administration has encouraged democratic political participation of the people of the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela through six national elections and referendums to ratify a new constitution and through the support of popular organizations called Bolivarian Circles.

WHEREAS, the Chavez administration has demonstrated a deep commitment to the social welfare of the people of the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela by providing increased access to free and low-cost health care, food and education and by providing employment through national public works program and by utilizing military resources to improve the social welfare of the Venezuelan people.

WHEREAS, President Hugo Chavez was illegally ousted from the presidency by antidemocratic forces and reinstated to the presidency through the popular and democratic support of the Venezuelan civil society.

WHEREAS, the Venezuela Solidarity Group, a group of San Francisco Bay Area residents, respects the democratically elected government of Hugo Chavez, supports the reforms made by the Chavez administration with the mandate of the Venezuelan people, and opposes foreign intervention in the affairs of sovereign, democratic nations.

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of San Francisco commends President Hugo Chavez of the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela for its commitment to democracy and its concern for the social welfare of its citizens.
