FILE NO. **021606** RESOLUTION NO. 689-02 1 [Opposing the UCSF decision to subcontract custodial services at Mission Bay.] 2 Resolution opposing the University of California at San Francisco (UCSF) decision to 3 subcontract custodial services at UCSF Mission Bay Campus. 4 5 WHEREAS, The University of California at San Francisco is in the process of opening 6 up one of the nation's most prestigious research facilities at Mission Bay; and 7 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco donated 13 acres of land to UCSF 8 9 for the purpose of building Mission Bay and providing good jobs for the Community; and, 10 WHEREAS, UCSF has already spent more than \$600 million dollars on the first phase 11 of Mission Bay development; and, WHEREAS, UCSF has told American Federation of State, County and Municipal 12 13 Employees (AFSCME) Local 3299 that they will be subcontracting custodial jobs, and possibly other service jobs, in order to pay workers less than the AFSCME Local 3299 contract rate 14 paid to other UCSF service workers; and, 15 16 WHEREAS, UCSF has informed AFSCME Local 3299 that custodians will be paid a lower hourly wage, with roughly 25% less overall compensation, through a subcontractor; and, 17 WHEREAS, AFSCME Local 3299 custodians make \$11-14/hour, with retirement and 18 health benefits; and, 19 WHEREAS, UCSF Mission Bay will ultimately need an estimated 600 service workers; 20 21 and, WHEREAS. Subcontracting promotes a "race to the bottom," by lowering already low 22 23 wages and benefits, making it harder to live and work in San Francisco; now, therefore, be it RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco 24 strongly opposes the subcontracting of UCSF Mission Bay jobs; and, be it 25 \*\*Supervisor,Gerardo Sandoval\*\*, Daly, Gonzalez, Yee, Leno, Peskin, McGoldrick
