[Urging Mayor Brown to make the prohibition of cell phone use while driving city vehicles a top priority in the coming negotiations between the City and various organizations representing City employees]

Resolution urging Mayor Brown to make the prohibition of cell phone use while driving city vehicles a top priority in the coming negotiations between the City and various organizations representing City employees.

WHEREAS, Research has found that driving an automobile while using a cell phone significantly increases the risk of accidents; and,

WHEREAS, A recent study published in the New England Journal of Medicine (Redelmeier 1997) found that there is a quadrupling of the risk of an automobile accident while operating a mobile phone; and,

WHEREAS. Research has found that cell phone use while driving has adverse effects on driver reaction time, mental workload, and vehicle lane positioning; and,

WHEREAS, Research on cell phone use while driving has found that complex conversations and intense or business related conversations increase crash risk; and,

WHEREAS, Research has found that phone use and driving are parallel tasks competing for the driver's attention; and,

WHEREAS, Analysis of the causes of mobile phone related crashes has shown the main reason for crashes is driver inattention; and,

WHEREAS, Research has shown that the most hazardous activity associated with mobile phone use is receiving a call because the driver cannot chose the time when a call is received; and,

WHEREAS, It is the intent of this resolution to protect public safety while ensuring that all city employees are treated in a fair and reasonable fashion; and,

WHEREAS, The Office of Mayor Brown will be conferring with various organizations representing City employees to renegotiate the City's Memorandums of Understanding; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That it is the policy of the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco that City employees shall be prohibited from using cell phones for non-emergency purposes while driving a city vehicle and that violations of this policy shall result in progressive disciplinary action; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of City and County of San Francisco urges Mayor Brown to make the prohibition of cell phone use while driving city vehicles a top priority in the coming negotiations between the City and various organizations representing City employees.
