WHEREAS, The 1996 Charter continued the authority under Section 10.104(15); and, WHEREAS, The Controller has certified on November 7, 2002 that Shelter and Intake Services for Status Offenders for the San Francisco Juvenile Probation Department can practically be performed by a private contractor at a lower cost than if the work were performed by City and County employees at budgeted levels; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that this Board Of Supervisor hereby concurs with the Controller's certification and declares its intention to enter into a contract for fiscal year 2002-2003 with Huckleberry Youth Programs, Inc., for Shelter and Intake Services for Status Offenders.
