WHEAREAS, This year marks the 10th Anniversary of Cesar E. Chavez's death on April 23, 2003; and,

WHEREAS, Governor Gray Davis on August 18, 2000 signed into law a bill declaring March 31 a state holiday for Cesar Chavez's birthday; and,

WHEREAS, The U.S. Postal Service will be issuing a commemorative, thirty-seven cent stamp on April 23, 2003 to honor Cesar E. Chavez's life's work and continuing legacy; and,

WHEREAS, San Francisco has a long and proud tradition of support and involvement in the United Farm Workers movement; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco recognize and celebrate the 3rd Annual Cesar E. Chavez Holiday Parade and Festival on March 30, 2003.
