WHEREAS, The Safe Havens program represents another step in developing the unique partnership between the City and County of San Francisco and the federal government in creating a comprehensive and community-based effort to combat domestic, family, and intimate partner violence which includes funding for Rally Family Visitation

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco hereby authorizes the Department of Children, Youth, & Their Families to accept and expend the \$350,000 from the Violence Against Women Office.
