WHEREAS, About one third of its 600 clients are children from schools all over the City of San Francisco and,

WHEREAS, OMI residents who otherwise might not seek treatment because of mobility or transportation limitations are able to receive services from the OMI Family Clinic because of its convenient location in the OMI; and,

WHEREAS, The staff's dedication to quality care for patients prompts clients from all over the city to seek services at the OMI Family Center; and,

WHEREAS, The OMI Family Center has never closed its doors to patients in need; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco urges the Mayor to preserve mental health services throughout the City and County of San Francisco and the vital resources the OMI Family Center provides for the residents of San Francisco.
