WHEREAS, This Board, through Resolution No. 62-03, approved the sale of Car #96 to the City of Issaquah, Washington, for \$15,000, with the proceeds to be used for the purchase, repair or rehabilitation of other vintage streetcars at the discretion of the Director of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, The Director of Transportation has determined that the \$15,000 be used to acquire Historic Streetcar #162 from OERM; and,

WHEREAS, MUNI has determined that the F-Market-Embarcadero Vintage Streetcar line will require additional vehicles in order to provide an adequate level of passenger service; and

WHEREAS, On April 1, 2003, Muni's Board of Directors passed Resolution No. 03-064, which urged this Board to accept the gift of \$55,000 from the Market Street Railway; now, therefore, be it
