RESOLUTION NO. 370-03

[Prevailing wage rates for workers in public off-street parking lots, garages or storage facilities for automobiles]

Resolution fixing the prevailing wage rates for workers in public off-street parking lots, garages, or storage facilities for automobiles on property owned or leased by the City.

WHEREAS, Administrative Code Section 21.25-2 requires the Board of Supervisors ("the Board") to fix the prevailing rate of wages, including fringe benefits or the matching equivalents thereof and including wages paid for holiday and overtime work, for workers in public off-street parking lots, garages, or automobile storage facilities on property owned or leased by the City and County of San Francisco ("the City"); and

WHEREAS, for that purpose Administrative Code Section 21.25-2 requires the Board to annually determine the prevailing rate of wages paid in private employment in the City for individuals working in off-street parking lots, garages, or automobile storage facilities; and

WHEREAS, Administrative Code Section 21.25-2 requires the Civil Service Commission ("the Commission") to furnish to the Board data as to the prevailing rate of wages paid in private employment in the City for individuals working in off-street parking lots, garages, or automobile storage facilities; and,

WHEREAS, The Commission at its March 3, 2003 meeting had for its consideration the Certification of the Prevailing Rate of Wages for workers employed in public off-street parking lots, garages, or storage facilities for automobiles, and for that purpose reviewed a report on that subject prepared by the Department of Human Resources, on file with the Clerk of the

Civil Service Commission BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

Board in File No. 030693, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

WHEREAS, The Commission decided to adopt the aforementioned report; and,

WHEREAS, The aforementioned report includes three groups of data -

- 1) the State of California's Employment Development Division ("EDD") California Cooperative Occupational Information System, which reports that the 1999-2001 rate of pay for unionized parking lot attendants ranged from \$7.50 to \$17.50 an hour, and for non-unionized parking lot attendants from \$8.00 to \$13.04 an hour, depending on experience;
- 2) the State of California's EDD Occupational Employment Statistics Survey for 2001, updated to the third quarter of 2002, which reports that for parking lot attendants the entry level hourly wage was \$6.83, the mean hourly wage was \$9.84, and the median hourly wage was \$8.92; and
- 3) the Garage and Parking Lot Agreement between Parking Employers and Teamsters Automotive Employees, Local 665, which provides that, for the period December 1, 2002 through November 30, 2003, the rate of pay for parking and garage attendants ranges from \$10.50 to \$17.50 an hour depending on experience; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board fixes the prevailing rate of wages, including fringe benefits or the matching equivalents thereof and wages paid for holiday and overtime work, for workers in public off-street parking lots, garages, or automobile storage facilities on property owned or leased by the City, as that rate paid for similar work in private employment in the City, as follows: The Garage and Parking Lot Agreement between Parking Employers and

Teamsters Automotive Employees, Local 665, which provides that, for the period December 1, 2002 through November 30, 2003, the rate of pay for parking and garage attendants ranges from \$10.50 to \$17.50 an hour depending on experience.
