WHEREAS, the Department of Parking and Traffic (DPT) and Chinatown Community Development Center (Chinatown CDC) received a Metropolitan Transportation Commission Transportation for Livable Communities Planning Grant for the Stockton Street corridor from the northern mouth of the Stockton Street tunnel to Broadway; and
