5 WHEREAS, San Francisco has been a leading force in the efforts to provide health
6 coverage for all its citizens; and

7 WHEREAS, San Francisco was the second county in the United States to provide low-
8 cost health coverage to children under 18 regardless of immigration status, and the first
9 county in the country to extend this Health Kids program to 18-24 year olds; and

10 WHEREAS, Public and private partnerships between the San Francisco Health Plan
11 and community organizations such as the San Francisco Organizing Project have resulted in
12 thousands of children receiving health coverage; and

13 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Organizing Project, as part of the PICO California
14 Project, and the 100% Campaign launched the California for Healthy Kids Campaign in
15 support of a statewide legislation that would ensure all California children have healthcare;
16 and

17 WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 772 and Senate Bill 437 would provide such health
18 coverage and are being voted on in Senate and Assembly Appropriations Committees this
19 month, therefore be it

20 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
21 do hereby proclaim their support for Assembly Bill 772 and Senate Bill 437.
