CITY HALL HEARING ON PROPOSED RESTRICTIONS ON DOG ACCESS TO FEDERAL RECREATION AREAS IN SAN FRANCISCO

Supervisor Scott Wiener to hold hearing at Board of Supervisors on dramatic reduction in dog access at Fort Funston, Crissy Field, Ocean Beach, and other federal properties

WHAT: Hearing at Board of Supervisors on proposed GGNRA restrictions on dog access

WHEN: Monday October 21, 2013, at 1:30 pm

WHERE: City Hall Room 250 (Land Use & Economic Development Committee)

The National Park Service is proposing a draft dog management plan that would severely restrict dog access in the Golden Gate National Recreation Area, including Crissy Field, Ocean Beach, and Fort Funston, as well as parts of Marin and San Mateo Counties. Supervisor Wiener is very concerned about the impact of these restrictions on dog owners and walkers, as well as the impact on city parks if dogs are displaced from these federal recreation areas.

As a result, Supervisor Wiener will conduct a hearing at City Hall on October 21. The Supervisor encourages interested persons to attend and participate in the hearing.
