Chair Peskin moved that this Ordinance be AMENDED, AN AMENDMENT OF THE WHOLE BEARING NEW TITLE, on Page 1, Line 5, to insert "registered contact lobbyist, permit consultants"; Page 1, Line, 6, to replace "appointed" with "elected officials"; Page 1, Line 17, to insert "deleting Section 3.620 and 3.620"; Page 2, Lines 12-13, to insert the definition of Department head; Page 3, Lines 4-13, to insert definition of various interested parties; Page 4, Line 15, to replace "3.605" with "3.610. PROHIBITING ELECTED OFFICIALS"; to replace "appointed" with "elected officials" throughout the legislation; Page 5, Line 1, to replace "six" with "twelve"; Page 5, Lines 13-18, to insert "(4) Lobbyists. Elected officials, department heads, commissioners, and designated employees may not solicit any behested payment from a contact lobbyist or expenditure lobbyist who has registered as a lobbyist with the Ethics Commission. (5) Permit consultants. Elected officials, department heads, commissioners, and designated employees may not solicit any behested payment from a permit consultant who has registered with the Ethics Commission"; Page 5, Lines 23-25, to insert "(b) EXCEPTION – PUBLIC APPEALS. This Section 3.610 shall not apply to public appeals"; and added other clarifying and conforming changes. The motion carried by the following vote:

Ordinance amending the Administrative Code by setting March 31 as the annual due date to pay registration fees for weighing and measuring devices and automated point of sale stations used for commercial purposes; retroactively eliminating fees billed by the Tax Collector on or after January 1, 2019, through fees otherwise due prior to March 31, 2025, for each business with a taximeter device; refunding eliminated fees paid to the City, and any penalties paid on such fees; and updating administrative fees to conform with the State of California's annual device administrative fee schedule.
