WHEREAS, It is the policy of the Board of Supervisors that each program of the City and county of San Francisco be the subject of a performance or management audit at least once every eight years; and

WHEREAS, The function of regular audits is to ensure that city departments and agencies make prudent and efficient use of city resources and also effectively perform the functions assigned to them by the charter and applicable laws; and,

WHEREAS, Rule 6.18 of the Rules of Order outlines the criteria to be used in developing the proposed audit schedule, and those priorities include programs that have never undergone a management audit as well as programs that have gone the longest period of time since their last management audit; and,

WHEREAS, The Budget Analyst is in the completion phase of (a) a management audit and policy review of Citywide Jobs Creation Programs and (b) a management audit and policy review of Citywide Information Technology functions, which are the last remaining audits under its current audit, be it

MOVED, That the Budget Analyst is hereby directed to include in its schedule of audits, in the following order of priority, (a) an evaluation of all of the City's plans and programs to encourage and assist City employees to lead a healthy lifestyle; (b) an audit follow up of the implementation of recommendations regarding cash handling practices at the Recreation and Park Department; (c) an audit of the Marina Yacht Harbor fund sources and uses of funds and the appropriateness of expenditures from the fund; and (d) an analysis of fixed post staffing in City and County operated jails; and, be it

FURTHER MOVED, that the Budget Analyst is directed to assign professional staff to all projects in a manner that, in the judgment of the Budget Analyst, results in maximum effectiveness for utilization of Budget Analyst resources, and be it

FURTHER MOVED, That the Budget Analyst is authorized to initiate focused special projects to the extent that staff resources are available and if there are no pending special project assignments as directed by the Board of Supervisors, after informing the President of the Board of Supervisors and the Chair of the Government Audit and Oversight Committee.
