12 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

13 Section 1. Article 13 of the San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by
14 adding Section 10.100-221, to read as follows:

15 Sec. 10.100-221. PUBLIC HEALTH SUBSTANCE ABUSE AND CRIME PREVENTION ACT
16 TRUST FUND.

17 **(a) Establishment of Fund.**

18 The Public Health Substance Abuse and Crime Prevention Act Trust Fund is established as a
19 category four fund to receive all funds from the California Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs
20 pursuant to the Substance Abuse and Crime Prevention Act of 2000.

21 **(b) Use of the Fund.**

22 Monies deposited in the fund shall be expended only for the purposes enumerated in the Act and
23 in the California Code of Regulations, Title 9, Division 4, Chapter 2.5


1 (c) Administration of Fund.

2 The Department of Public Health is hereby designated to be the lead agency responsible for
3 administration of the fund as required under California Code of Regulations, Title 9, Section
4 9515(b)(1). As the lead agency, the Department of Health will carry out the responsibility of
5 implementing the Substance Abuse and Crime Prevention Act of 2000 for the City and County of San
6 Francisco.
