Underground District No. 350

(Mid-Folsom Street District)

covering Folsom Street from 16th Street to Cesar Chavez Street.

Section 2. The undergrounding of facilities within this underground district is in the general public interest in that said action will eliminate a heavy concentration of overhead wires on a street that is extensively used by the general public and carries a heavy volume of pedestrian and vehicular traffic.
