WHEREAS, Safe shelters mean less people sleeping on the streets being subjected to unsafe environmental conditions; and,

WHEREAS, There are reports sexual assault and other criminal misconduct in the shelters; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors urges the Mayor's Office on Homelessness and the Department of Human Services to create a system for tracking criminal misconduct in the City's shelter system.
