

1 [Medallion Waiting List Information]  
2 URGING THE SAN FRANCISCO TAX COLLECTOR’S OFFICE, WORKING WITH THE POLICE  
3 DEPARTMENT’S TAXI DETAIL AND THE CITY ATTORNEY’S OFFICE TO INFORM  
4 WORKING TAXI DRIVERS ABOUT THE STEPS REQUIRED TO OBTAIN A TAXI  
5 MEDALLION BY MAKING THIS INFORMATION AVAILABLE TO DRIVERS DURING THEIR  
6 ANNUAL A-CARD RENEWAL EVERY YEAR.

7 WHEREAS, Proposition K, passed by the voters in 1979, created a new class of permit holders,  
8 notably imposing a driving requirement on permit holders in exchange for the privilege of holding a  
9 City-owned medallion; and,

10 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Police Commission developed a method of doling out permits,  
11 based on names submitted to the waiting list; and,

12 WHEREAS, In furtherance of the intent of Proposition K, the San Francisco Police Code allows  
13 preference in the waiting list to be given to persons who have been driving for at least one year; and,

14 WHEREAS, Presently, no method exists for informing drivers of the need to put their name on  
15 this waiting list as a prerequisite to be considered for holding a medallion as these medallions become  
16 available; and,

17 WHEREAS, Drivers must register on an annual basis with the Tax Collector’s Office in order to  
18 receive their A-card, a permit to drive a taxi; and,

19 WHEREAS, The Tax Collector’s Office previously conducted a successful survey of drivers by  
20 disseminating surveys during A-card renewals; now, therefore, be it

21 RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco does hereby urge the San Francisco  
22 Tax Collector’s Office, working with the Police Department’s Taxi Detail and the City Attorney’s  
23 Office, to inform working taxi drivers about the steps required to obtain a taxi medallion by making this  
24 information available to drivers during their annual A-card renewal every year; and, be it


