

1 [San Jose Avenue Traffic Measures]

2 Resolution urging the Department of Parking and Traffic to  
3 create a San Jose Avenue bicycle lane and to implement traffic  
4 calming measures between Randall and Tiffany Streets.

6 WHEREAS, Pedestrian and bicyclist deaths in California  
7 account for 25 percent of all traffic related fatalities in any  
8 given year and San Francisco has seen an alarming rise in  
9 fatalities as well; and,

10 WHEREAS, Safe and convenient places to walk and bicycle are  
11 essential elements of retaining a high quality of life and a  
12 commitment to public safety in San Francisco; and,

13 WHEREAS, Residents who live near San Jose Avenue between  
14 Randall and Tiffany Streets have increasingly made reports that  
15 the Avenue is dangerous for pedestrians and bicyclists who use  
16 it frequently; and,

17 WHEREAS, Residents should be able to walk or bicycle safely  
18 in San Francisco; and,

19 WHEREAS, The residents who live near San Jose Avenue  
20 have proposed several safety measures including a bicycle lane  
21 from Randall to Tiffany Street, a speed limit reduction from  
22 45MPH to 35MPH on the Northbound San Jose Avenue from the  
23 Highland Bridge to Randall, and application of rumble strips or  
24 other traffic calming applications at San Jose Avenue heading  
25 Northbound from the Highland Bridge; now, therefore, be it




